# Why should I be a Sunday Prayer Warrior?

- The greatest spiritual battles are won through prayer.
- Statistics have shown a direct correlation between the number of people praying during our Worship Celebration and the movement of the Holy Spirit in the celebration.
- You directly impact God's work by praying.
- Your prayers are important and vital.
- Pastor Michael relies on intercessors!

# Who can be a Sunday Prayer Warrior?

- Anyone who is an Englewood Baptist Church member, and 18 years of age or older can be a Sunday Prayer Warrior.
- Children under the age of 18 may pray with an adult that is already a committed Warrior.

# How often will I be a Sunday Prayer Warrior?

- You commit to pray four times a year.
- You commit to pray only once per quarter.
- You commit to pray only one hour on one Sunday each quarter.
- You commit to pray during one of our Sunday morning Worship Celebrations or during our evening Worship Celebration for one hour on one Sunday each quarter.

# Will I miss the sermon?

# Where do I pray during my hour?

- You may pray in the Global Prayer Hall.



- You may prayer-walk anywhere in the building while you pray. Please sign the attendance book before you prayer-walk.

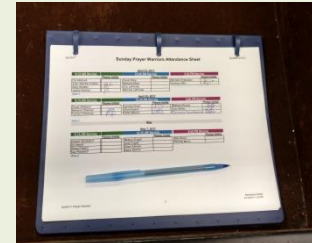
# Where do I pray during my hour? Continued

- You may pray in the Prayer Suite foyer. Please sign the attendance book before entering the Prayer Suite as you can only exit the Prayer Suite via the exterior door.
- The Prayer Suite is adjacent to the Global Prayer Hall.



# How will you know that I prayed?

- Please sign the attendance book located inside the coffee table.

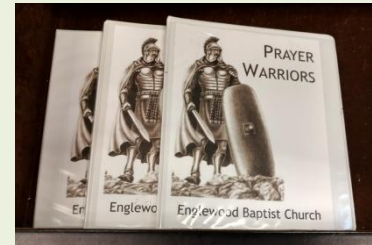


- Beyond that, it's an honor system. This is a commitment we hope you will keep since ultimately it's a commitment between you and God.



# What do I pray during my hour?

- You may pray in any way that the Holy Spirit leads you.
- You may pray out loud as a group, or privately and silently.
- You may use the Prayer Guides provided. They are located inside the coffee table.



# What is in the Prayer Guide?

- The Prayer Guide is divided into sections.
  1. Confession
  2. Praise
  3. Seeking God's glory
  4. Praying for the Worship Celebration
  5. Praying for EBC leaders
  6. Praying for the body of EBC
  7. Praying for the invitation

You may pray in any or all of the sections.
- It's particularly important to pray during the time you estimate to be the Invitation. This is the time that the spiritual battle intensifies. Prayer Warriors arise!
