Who will go? In Matthew 28:19 instructs the believers (then and now) to "... go and make disciples of all nations ..." This was His command and directive to us as believers to go. **Why would Christ want us to go** to be witnesses in "... Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth?" It is important to have an active passport. You may download a copy of the application from the web at <http://travel.state.gov/passport>. You will need the following to receive the passport:

- State issued birth certificate
- 2 passport pictures
- Proof of identity (driver's license, etc.)
- Fee

Pray for guidance: God will direct you to the short term trip He has designed for you. Be patient, seek His face, and pray!

Complete an application form: You may receive the application form in the church office.

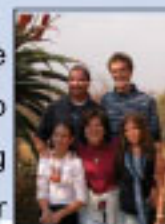
Your Journey Begins Now!

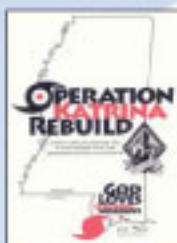
